STEP 1: How to begin?

1. **Prayer:** Our country is in a great culture war, and we know that the best way for us to battle is on our knees. And the best source to turn to is the very Word of God. God can do mighty things through our prayers. “If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.” 2 Chronicles 7:14. Other scripture references are: Isaiah 60:2-3, Psalm 33:12, 1 Timothy 2:1-5, Daniel 2:20-21, Romans 13:1, Matthew 6:9-10, Proverbs 14:34, Proverbs 9:10, Proverbs 18:4, Corinthians 13:4-7, Ephesians 4:31-32, Philippians 2:3-4, 1 Corinthians 1:10, and Daniel 9:19 (scripture references from Jenn Soehlin).
2. **Register to Vote:** Register to vote. Once registered, become informed about candidates, and vote in every election. Vote at the Polling Locations (mail-in voting is subject to election fraud).

They begin every meeting with a Christian prayer and the pledge of allegiance and they bring in speakers (candidates who are running for office and others) and they give you an opportunity to ask questions. You'll learn firsthand who are the candidates and issues you want to support.

Neighborhood Councils provide advisory input on all areas of government that affect your neighborhoods. This could include areas such as finance, parking, planning, zoning, police, and parks, but they are not limited to these topics. The Councils are advisory to the City Commission, City staff, City Boards and Commissions, and other government entities as well. There are currently nine Great Falls Councils made up of five (5) members each. Members of the Council are elected to two-year terms during the City General Election. Some of the Councils have vacancies. You do not need to be a member of a Council to attend their meetings. Click on your Council (Council 4 is shown below).
